STRATEGIES FOR THE SOCIALLY ANXIOUS

- Subscribe to your church's YouTube channel, social media pages, or leave a Google review to help others find us
- Like/Comment on your church's content so that Facebook/Instagram increases our church's visibility
- Share posts/clips/messages on your personal page so that your friends can view them
- Email/message a specific friend who might need to hear a particular message published by our church

STRATEGIES FOR THE SOCIAL BUTTERFLY

- When it comes up in conversation, share about the impact your church is having on you/your family
- When you discover a shared interest, invite a friend to a community event put on by our church (i.e. topical class, children's event, etc.)
- If it appears they might be open to trying church again, text them on Friday or Saturday night giving them the option to sit with you
